PARTNER TO SUPPORT ANTI-TERRORISM CAUSE**

*NeuStar to Donate \$1.00 to the Rewards for Justice Fund  
For Every .US Registration During September 2002*

STERLING, Va., Sept. 4, 2002... NeuStar, Inc. and the Rewards for Justice Fund have joined forces this month on an initiative enabling U.S. citizens, permanent residents and businesses to contribute to the anti-terrorism effort while simultaneously demonstrating national pride. For every registration of a .US Internet address during the month of September, NeuStar will donate \$1.00 to the Rewards for Justice Fund, a non-profit charity established in the days after the September 11 tragedy to allow private individuals and organizations to contribute to the U.S. government's anti-terrorism efforts.

The Rewards for Justice Fund turns over 100 percent of the money it raises to the U.S. State Department's Rewards for Justice Program, which provides reward payments to individuals who help identify or apprehend terrorists. Since the program's establishment in 1984, it has paid out approximately \$9.5 million in rewards and played a key role in the apprehension of dozens of terrorists around the world. One of the program's greatest success stories was the arrest of Ramzi Ahmed Yousef, who is currently serving time for his role in the 1993 bombing of the World Trade Center.

"For the countless number of Americans who want to demonstrate their patriotism and support the anti-terrorism cause, NeuStar's offer represents a terrific opportunity," said Scott Case, co-founder of the Rewards for Justice Fund. domain for the United States. Since making the domain name available to the general public on April 24, 2002, NeuStar has enabled several hundred thousand U.S. citizens, residents, businesses, organizations and government entities to establish patriotic Internet identities.

“Like many other U.S. companies, we wanted to find a way to demonstrate support for our great nation,” said Jeffrey E. Ganek, chairman and CEO of NeuStar. “We were impressed with the Rewards for Justice Fund since it is the only charitable organization that enables the public to directly contribute to anti-terrorism efforts. We are honored to support their cause and look forward to building a lasting partnership with them,” he added.

Besides accepting direct donations and contributions from NeuStar for .US registrants, the Rewards for Justice Fund receives 100 percent of the proceeds from purchases of “United We Stand” license plates. The plates currently are available in five states: Florida, Virginia, South Carolina, New Jersey and Connecticut.
